What is PATH?

The PATH Program is provided to support individuals with serious mental illnesses, as well as individuals with co-occurring substance use disorders, who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

What services does PATH provide?

- Community Outreach
- Diagnostic Screening and Therapeutic treatment for serious mental illness
- Case management services
- Referrals for substance abuse, primary healthcare, job training, educational opportunities, and housing
- Assistance in connecting with and applying for resources in the community
